Compost Yard Manager, Broken Bow NE

We are looking for an individual to manage our compost yard in Broken Bow at Adam's Feedyard. We started composting there in June of 2025 and anticipate to expand production rapidly to meet demand and keep up with product coming into the yard. BioAg is receiving all the concrete pen material so as the number of cattle on concrete rises, more manure is going to come into the compost yard. For this spring we are planning to move 20,000 ton of material with hopes of expanding that to 80,000 tons next year.

Duties include, Managing the compost yard. Help organize staff as more people come on board. Monitor the flow of raw manure in and compost going out. We need someone who can foresee what's to come and help position people and equipment to ensure timely movement of product in and out of the yard. This person will be expected to run loaders, turners, compost screen as well as monitor daily maintenance and repair work that is needed. Heavy equipment experience is highly desired.

Compost Yard Assistant:
