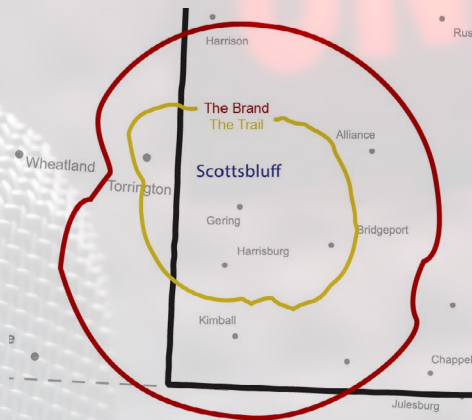

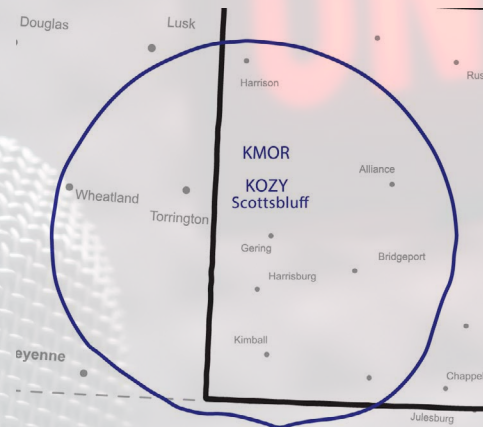

The Nebraska Rural Radio Association went on the air in 1951 with a simple mission; to serve agriculture and rural Nebraska. Thanks to the vision of The Nebraska Cooperative Council, Nebraska Farm Bureau, Nebraska Farmers Union and the Nebraska State Grange, the Nebraska Rural Radio Association became the only farmer and rancher owned radio organization in the country.

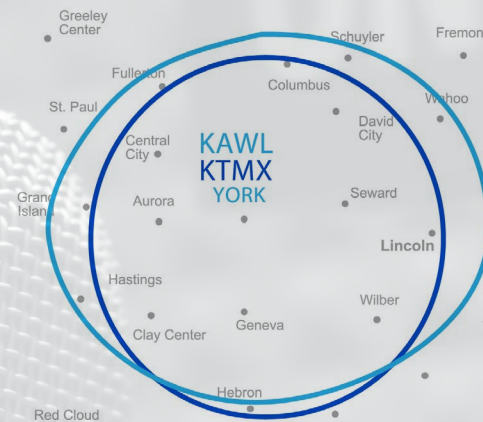

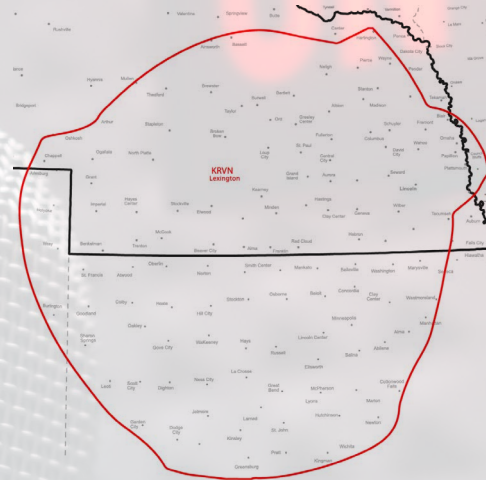

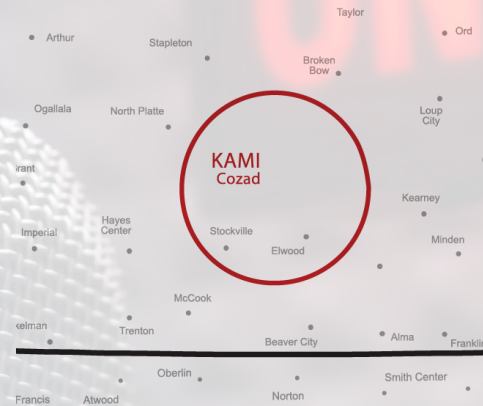

The station was purchased by the Nebraska Rural Radio Association in 2020. In 2021, KUVR also began broadcasting on HD radios at 93.1 Channel 4.

As the **"live and local voice of Holdrege and Phelps County"**, KUVR features live news, weather and a daily community information segment called "Town Talk". Sports coverage includes Holdrege Duster high school, Nebraska Cornhusker college and Kansas City Chiefs pro football.

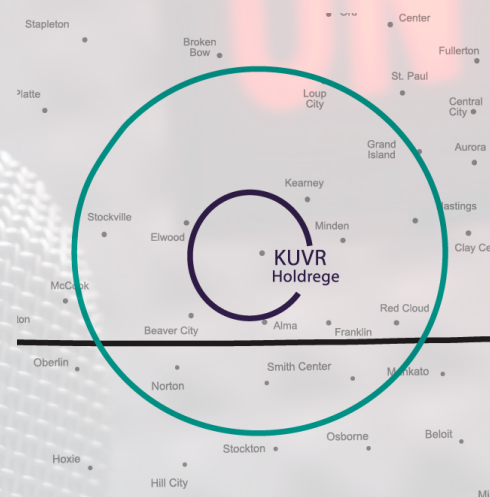
